

Journal Publishing Agreement Author Copyright

Panoramic: The Leiden Art Review

The following is an agreement between

_____ (the “Author”)

and

Panoramic: The Leiden Art Review _____ (the “Journal”)

which governs

The parties desire to promote effective scholarly communication that promotes local control of intellectual assets. The parties for valuable consideration agree as follows.

A. AUTHOR’S GRANT OF RIGHTS

The Author grants to the Journal, during the full term of copyright and any extensions or renewals of that term, the following:

1. An irrevocable non-exclusive right to reproduce, republish, transmit, sell, distribute, and otherwise use the Work in electronic and print editions of the Journal.
2. An irrevocable non-exclusive right to create and store electronic archival copies of the Work, including the right to deposit the Work in open access digital repositories.
3. An irrevocable non-exclusive right to license others to reproduce, republish, transmit, and distribute the Work under the condition that the Authors are attributed. (Currently this is carried out by publishing the content under a Creative Commons Attribution 3.0 license.)

Copyright in the Work remains with the Authors.

B. AUTHOR’S DUTIES

1. When distributing or re-publishing the Work, the Author agrees to credit the Journal as the place of first publication.

C. AUTHOR’S WARRANTY

The Author represents and warrants that the Work is the Author’s original work and that it does not violate or infringe the law or the rights of any third party and, specifically, that the Work contains no matter that is defamatory or that infringes any

literary or proprietary rights, intellectual property rights, or any rights of privacy. The Author also warrants that he or she has the full power to make this agreement. The Author agrees to hold the Journal harmless from any breach of the aforesated representations.

D. JOURNAL'S DUTIES

In consideration of the Author's grant of rights, the Journal agrees to publish the Work, attributing the Work to the Author.

E. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This agreement reflects the entire understanding of the parties. This agreement may be amended only in writing by an addendum signed by the parties. Amendments are incorporated by reference to this agreement.
